

Student Teachers

The school district will work cooperatively with accredited teacher-preparation programs from colleges and universities to provide apprentice teaching opportunities for student teachers. Cooperating teachers shall receive no compensation from either the district or the preparatory institution to supervise a student teacher. The Superintendent, acting for the district, shall have the authority to reject working with any institute requesting to place student teachers in the district.

The principal shall determine the number of student teachers that shall be placed in his/her building at any one time or in any given year.

All student teachers shall be under the direct authority of the cooperating teacher and the building principal. Student teachers not able to follow the guidelines as set forth by the cooperating teacher and/or the building principal, or who in any way violate those standards as set forth for regularly employed teachers, shall have their student teaching relationship terminated.
