

Tutoring

It is expected that every effort will be made by school personnel to help students overcome any learning difficulties. However, there may be instances when a parent/guardian requests, or school personnel may recommend, that a tutoring situation be considered.

The following guidelines shall be established when Kimball Public Schools staff persons are engaged in a “tutoring” situation:

1. Unless otherwise specified, any tutoring services provided by employees of the Kimball Public Schools shall be paid for by the parent/guardian. Instructional assistance in situations involving disciplinary-type situations, i.e. suspensions/expulsions, or long-term health care situations, are generally not considered tutoring under definitions of this policy.
2. Tutoring services for which the parent/guardian is paying a fee to the Kimball Public School’s employee shall be conducted off school premises unless expressed permission is granted to use school facilities for this purpose by the Superintendent or his/her designee.
