

Teacher Organization Rights

Any employee organization recognized by the Board of Education shall have the right to the following:

1. Use of the school buildings for meetings, when times/places have been approved in advance of any such meetings by the Superintendent or his/her designee.
2. Use of school equipment at reasonable times and when such equipment is not in use by students. Equipment shall not be removed from school property without expressed approval by the Superintendent or his/her designee. A reasonable charge for district owned supplies and/or the use of school-owned equipment may be charged by the Board of Education to the employee organization.
3. Use of interschool mail facilities. Permission of the Superintendent or his/her designee is required.
4. Use of space in buildings to post information and notices. Such "space" shall be mutually agreed upon by the organization and the building principal. All posted materials shall be in good taste and of a professional nature. Distribution of any materials by an employee organization within/between buildings or to the outside of the school shall be approved by the Superintendent or his/her designee.
