

Negotiations

During negotiations with any employee organization, the board and the employee organization shall present relevant data, exchange points of view, and make proposals and counter-proposals. The board shall make available upon request by the organization any information that is considered to be available to the public at large.

Neither party in any negotiations shall have any control over the selection of the negotiating representatives of the other party, except that no member of the administrative team may represent the teacher group.

Ground rules for conducting of actual negotiations meetings between the board and the recognized employee organizations shall be mutually agreed upon by both parties. All aspects of the law shall be adhered to during the negotiations session.
