

Compulsory Attendance

As per state statutes, all persons at least seven years of age and up to sixteen years of age shall be in attendance each day in school unless excused by school officials. Being in attendance shall mean in public or private school or at a “home school” for which a Department of Education waiver is required.

For a student to be enrolled in the Kimball Public Schools, the student must have attained his/her 5th birthday prior to October 15th of the year of enrollment. No person may attend school without tuition charge if he/she has reached his/her twenty-first birthday prior to the start of the current school year.

Excusal from the “full-time” requirement of the compulsory education law can be granted by the superintendent for a child between 14 and 16 years of age having completed the work of the eighth grade when legal employment due to necessity has been obtained by the student and such a request has been made by a parent/guardian.
