

Operation and Maintenance of Plant

An effective educational program requires clean, healthy, safe, and attractive physical facilities. The maintenance and custodial staff is charged with the responsibility for caring and adequately maintaining the facilities.

The Director of Buildings and Grounds with input from the building principals supervises the work of the custodial staff, seeing that the custodial responsibilities are carried out satisfactorily.

The overall evaluation of the maintenance and custodial program in the district shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent of Schools, utilizing the input from the administrative staff and the Director of Buildings and Grounds.

The Director of Buildings and Grounds shall have the responsibility of hiring the custodial staff, assigning staff work schedules, and making recommendation to the Superintendent when staff changes are needed.
