

Facility and Site Planning

The board shall include the building, facilities, or sites necessary for the school district's educational programs as part of the board's long range plans.

The board may engage the services of consultants or other personnel to study the needs of the school district's facilities. The results of these services will be considered in planning the education program and in making decisions about the improvements and acquisition of additional sites or construction of additional facilities.

It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent of school to provide information including, but not limited to, enrollment projections, educational program needs and requirements, and recommendations on facilities studies to the board of education.

Prior to remodeling or other construction of buildings or facilities, the board may appoint a committee of consultants, employees, citizens, or other to assist the board in developing the facilities specifications or plans.
